Hotel Accommodations

We've reserved a block of 10 rooms at a discounted rate for McNary grads:

- **Rate:** \$99.00 per room, per night + \$12.78 tax = ~\$111.78 total per night
- **Eligible nights:** Saturday Aug. 8 through Monday Aug. 10 (up to 3 nights at the group rate) — or, if your schedule works better, Friday Aug. 7 through Sunday Aug. 9 is an alternate option. Either way, the discounted rate applies for up to 3 consecutive nights.

- **Checkout:** No later than Monday, August 10
- **Note:** The hotel's regular rate will appear when you first search — the discounted price will be applied at checkout when booking under the McNary block.
